Required language competencies	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applicants for clinical internships (medicine, pharmacy, nursing) are required to provide proof of language proficiency in German (at least B2, ideally C1).• Applicants for research internships are required to provide proof of language proficiency in English (at least B2 / preferably C1).• Diverse test certificates are accepted, such as IELTS, TOEFL, DAAD, Goethe-Zertifikat, Austrian Language certificate (ÖSD Zertifikat), Duolingo, a print-out of language test results from the Online Linguistic Support (OLS), or a letter of confirmation from a professor/lecturer of German/English are accepted.
