



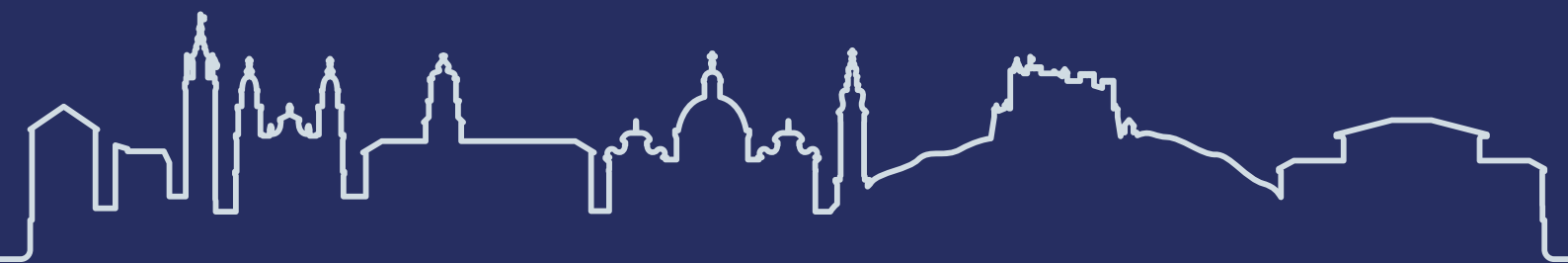

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Paracelsus Medical University (PMU) is a young, dynamic private university with a global outlook.

It aims to solve pressing medical and health issues that our societies face today through innovative and impactful teaching and research activities within and beyond its borders in the fields of medicine, pharmacy, and nursing.

With 23 university institutes, 4 research centres, and 6 research foci, the PMU, together with the Salzburg University Hospital, is able to offer first-class education programs and excellent research. In February 2014, the PMU established its second Campus in Nuremberg in cooperation with the Klinikum Nuremberg.

FIELD OF STUDIES

MEDICINE

Since 2003, Paracelsus Medical University has been offering an excellent medical program using international standards as a benchmark. The program is offered at both Nuremberg and Salzburg campuses. The aim of the program is to train highly skilled and competent medical doctors who are guided by scientific principles and humane ideals. Each year, 75 students at the Salzburg campus and 50 students at the Nuremberg campus are accepted into the program, following a rigorous three-stage admission process. The selection process favours socially committed and highly motivated applicants with a keen interest in both the biological and social aspects of human beings and the natural science and psychosocial facets of diseases. In addition, students must pass the USMLE in order to progress to year 4.

NURSING SCIENCE

Excellent medical care cannot be achieved without exceptional patient-centred care. In 2007, the PMU introduced a nursing science degree program in response to social, demographic, medical, and nursing developments. The primary aim of the Institute for Nursing Science is to prepare graduates as skilled and methodologically competent experts in the field of nursing care. The program emphasizes critical thinking, self-study, and bridging the gap between theory and practice, in addition to providing scientific knowledge and current professional content.

PHARMACY

The pharmacy degree program commenced in 2017, and in 2020, a sequential master's program was introduced. The curriculum is grounded in natural science and emphasizes practical skills. The program places a strong emphasis on clinical pharmacy and the connection between pharmaceutical theory and practice. The study program is well-organized and efficient, allowing for rapid learning and completion within five years.

FURTHER EDUCATION

Through the PMU ACADEMY, the PMU offers programs for further education. From university courses to seminars and training courses, you have the possibility to deepen or specialise in your core profession (e.g. in nursing), in inter-professional continuing education (such as in Early Life Care, Palliative Care or Health Sciences & Leadership) or attend specialized trainings (e.g. didactics, leadership, simulation training, or surgery courses).

APPLICATION PROCESS

ERASMUS STUDENT EXCHANGE

STUDENTS FROM PARTNER UNIVERSITIES

Your home university must nominate you first before you can send your application. The PMU does not charge tuition and laboratory fees for Erasmus+ students and students from key partner universities. However, all students enrolled in Austrian universities are required to pay the student union contribution per semester (€21,20 for 2023/2024) and student ID fees (approx. €60 for 2023/2024).

FREE MOVER

If your home university does not have a partnership agreement with the PMU, you can apply as a "free mover." Please inquire directly at the International Office regarding fees.



RESEARCH INTERNSHIP

Research internships are offered at the PMU Institutes in Salzburg and Nuremberg.

NOMINATION DEADLINES

For fall term: February 1st
For spring term: September 1st

APPLICATION DEADLINE

For fall term: March 1st
For spring term : October 1st

CLINICAL INTERNSHIP

Clinical internship is possible at the PMU University Hospital (PMU-Uniklinikum):

NOMINATION DEADLINES

September 1st the year prior to the planned internship.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Medicine:

Clinical internships begin every November. The application deadline is October 1st the year prior to the planned internship.

Nursing:

The application deadline is October 1st the year prior to the planned internship.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- Motivation letter
- Resumé
- Official transcript of records of the last two semesters completed prior to the application
- Language competency certificate
- Copy of passport

For research internship:

- a two-page description of the proposed research and potential research supervisor. The list of researchers and research topics can be found here: vsgt.pmu.ac.at/hmforschungsinstitute/

For clinical internship:

- in your motivation letter, you must indicate your specific department or area of interest.



APPLICATION PROCESS

LANGUAGE COMPETENCIES

For a research internship, you must have at least B2, ideally a C1 level in English; for a clinical internship, C1 in German is required, in addition to B2 or C1 in English.

We accept any of the following certificates: IELTS, TOEFL, Cambridge, DAAD, Goethe-Zertifikat, Austrian Language certificate, Duolingo or a print-out of your language test from Erasmus Online Linguistic Support.

ECTS AND GRADING SCALE

ECTS stands for European Credit Transfer System. ECTS enables comparability of academic degrees across Europe and refers to students' workload within a course of study. Each study program has its individual grading scale. Students will receive detailed information about the study regulations during the Orientation Days.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT

ACCEPTANCE LETTER

You will be informed about your acceptance within 5 weeks after the application deadline.

ENTRY AND VISA FORMALITIES IN SALZBURG

If you have an EU/EEA or Swiss nationality, you don't need a visa. If you are staying in Austria for 3 months or more, you have to register with the relevant municipal authority (Magistrat) in Salzburg within 5 days after your arrival and pay the registration fees of approx. €15 (additional fees may apply). The Magistrat will then issue you your confirmation of registration (Meldezettel).

If you are a national of a »third country,« you will need an entry and residence permit for entry to and residence in Austria. For more information, see the [guidelines for residence permits](#).



HEALTH INSURANCE IN SALZBURG

If you are an EU/EEA national, your European Health Insurance Card is valid in Austria. If you are a national of a »third country,« you can purchase a health insurance policy from the Austrian Health Insurance Fund (ÖGK) (approx. €64 per month) or any other private health insurance provider (QR code below) after your arrival in Salzburg.

ENTRY AND VISA FORMALITIES IN NUREMBERG

If you hold citizenship in an EU member state or are you a citizen of Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, or Switzerland you need to enter the country is a valid personal ID card or passport. After arriving in Germany and securing accommodation, it is necessary to register with the local Residents' Registration Office

If you are going to study in Nuremberg, you will need to apply for a student visa in Germany. After submission, you will be required to pay a student visa application fee. The visa application fee in Germany is approx. €150.

HEALTH INSURANCE IN NUREMBERG

The law in Germany requires everyone to have health insurance, including international students. European union students can rely on their European Health Insurance Card to cover healthcare services. Exchange students typically participate in degree programs, granting them the opportunity to qualify for public health insurance and avail themselves of the student discount.

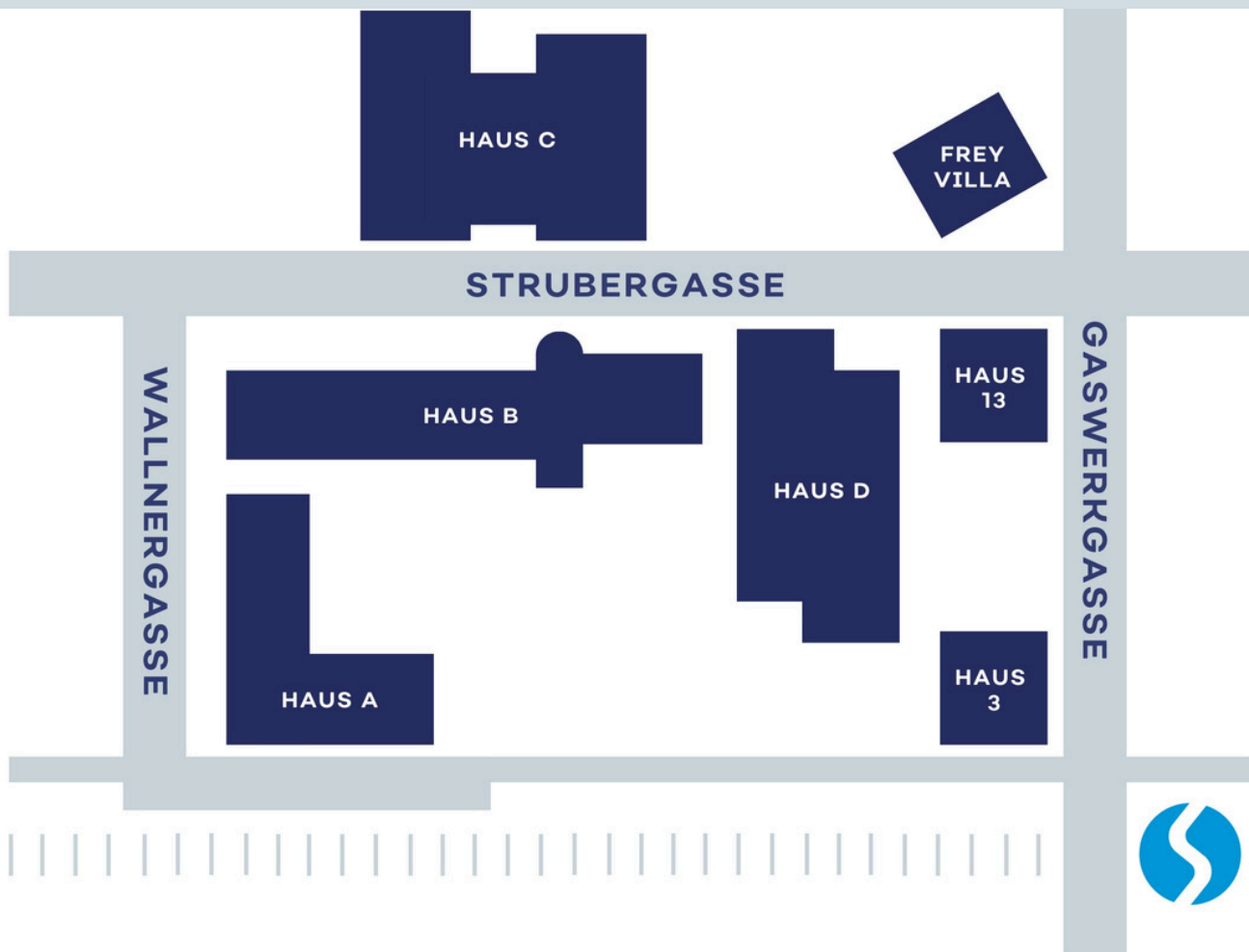
